## **Authority Projects**

- Wilden Acres Tank Painting
  - Tank Taken out of service Monday September 14<sup>th</sup>.
  - Pro-Spec will be mobilizing this week.
  - Work is scheduled to be completed in mid November, with the tank being placed back in service by December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Hodle Avenue
  - ESWA to replace 1,500' of 6" cast iron main with 8" ductile iron water main.
  - Several water main breaks over last five years.
  - Sinkhole prone area.
  - Water system work to begin in middle of September and should be completed by the middle of October.
- Morgan Hill High Service Pumping Station
  - Pump 3 was removed on August 3<sup>rd</sup> and is being rebuilt by Kohls Brothers.
  - Pump 3 was cleaned and rebuilt by Kohls Brothers. The pump motor is also being cleaned.
  - Pump 3 should be reinstalled and placed back in service the week of September 14<sup>th</sup>..
  - Maintenance will be scheduled on Pumps 1 and 2 during our lower demand period.
